1999 CANADA WINTER GAMES MEN'S GOLD MEDAL TEAM

The 1999 Canada Winter Games were hosted in Newfoundland and Labrador, helping the province celebrating its 50th anniversary of Confederation with Canada. For the members of the Team Alberta Male Hockey squad, they helped the host province celebrate by going undefeated to win Alberta's third gold medal in male hockey in Canada Games competition.
