

2018 INDUCTEE GRANT FUHR

Grant Fuhr was one of the National Hockey League's greatest goaltenders, playing on five Stanley Cup champion teams over a 20-year career (1981-2000) and earning induction into the Hockey Hall of Fame in 2003 in his first year of eligibility. The Spruce Grove native is best known for his 10 seasons with the Edmonton Oilers (1981-91). Grant was the Oilers' first-round draft pick (8th overall) in the 1981 NHL entry draft. He backstopped the Oilers to Stanley Cup titles in 1984, 1985, 1987, 1988 and 1990, appearing in 423 regular season games (228-117-54 record) and 112 playoff games (74-32). In a ceremony during the 2017 All-Star Weekend in Los Angeles, Grant was named one of the 100 Greatest NHL Players in 100 years of NHL history.
